- Core teachers will make advisements for next year based on current work ethic, attendance and academic discipline demonstrated this school year. These advisements are a guide; however, parent and student make the final decision regarding course selection. Teacher course advisements will be made during the week of January 21st through January 24th. These individual advisements can be found in **Parent Access (PAC)** and/or **Student Access (SAC)** under the 4 Year Plan tab.

- Elective Fair and Incoming 9th Grade Parent Information Night is Tuesday, January 28th. The Elective Fair is from 6:00 – 7:00 pm in the senior campus cafeteria. The Parent Information Night is at 7:00 pm in the senior campus Auditorium.
