Interested in Dual Credit Precalculus?

- Juniors must have completed Algebra 2 PreAP or higher to take the class.
- Students who pass DC College Algebra already qualify but students who need to test must pass all sections to qualify.
- Talk to your math teacher and counselor to hear their recommendations.

Important!

- Students who take the TSI must take ALL THREE subjects the first time they test: Reading, Writing, and Math.
- You can retest for \$11 per subject retest on the TWHS campus. Your TSI proctor will sign you up on the day you test.
