Dear Highlander Parents and Students,

TWHS students took the STAAR EOC (State of Texas Assessment of Academic Readiness End Of Course) assessments for Algebra 1, Biology, English 1, English 2 and US History during the spring of this school year. High school graduation is dependent upon a passing score on all five of these tests. Our records indicate your student was absent from or did not pass one or more of the EOC tests at a previous administration. We strongly encourage all students to retest this summer if they did not meet the passing standard. We would also suggest they take advantage of the free boot camp offered at the TWHS 9th grade campus to help prepare them to take the exam. Details about boot camp and summer testing are listed below. **Please note, due to the hiring of staff and use of building facilities we need an accurate count of numbers testing this summer. Therefore, it is vital that your student be registered for boot camp and testing by June 12, 2019.** If you have any questions or concerns, please contact the grade level office at 936-709-1473. Algebra, Biology and US History are four (4) hour tests  
English 1 and 2 are five (5) hour tests

### **Procedures for the day of the test:**

1. arrive at senior campus no later than 7:30; **MUST HAVE PHOTO ID (driver's license, school id, passport)**
2. check in at the grade level office on the 2<sup>nd</sup> floor; find out testing room number at check in.
3. complete the exam; when finished, students must exit the testing room and leave campus.

Parents may pick up and drop off in the front of the building. To locate the grade level office: enter the front door, turn left and follow hallway to cafeteria. Go up the cafeteria stairs and turn right. Grade Level Office is on the left. Summer school students receive an excused absence when they return to class after testing.
