



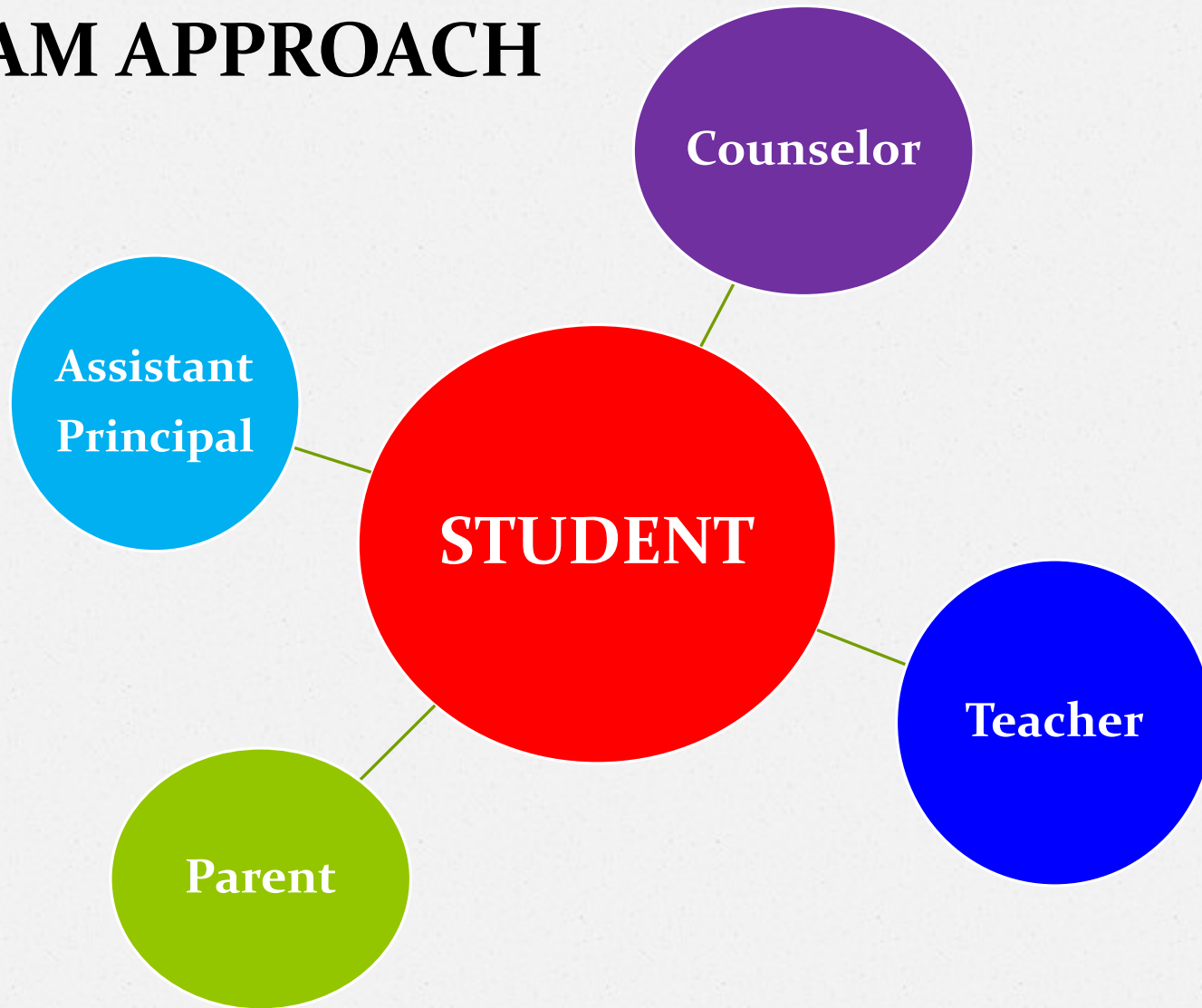

ATTENDANCE POLICY

- Texas law requires that students be in attendance in all courses 90% of each semester regardless of the reasons for the absence.
- If students fall below 90%, then both students and parents are notified in writing by the assistant principal.
- A plan will be made at that point to help the student make up the absences. If the absences are not made up at that point, then the student will possibly lose credit for that course.
- Ten unexcused absences will result in a referral to county court for potential prosecution for truancy.
- Parents must report student absences within 48 hours for consideration of excused absences. After 48 hours, absences will be coded as unexcused and will not be reversed after 48 hours.

AP v. Dual Credit

AP= Advanced Placement

- College Level Course where students may earn college credits based on AP Exam score taken in May
- Scored 1-5 (5 is highest)
- College credit determined by College or University attending

AP v. Dual Credit

Dual Credit

- Course gives credit at LSC *and* TWHS
- College credit received by earning a 70 or above in the course.
- College Readiness testing required:
PSAT/SAT/ACT/TSI
- Tuition : Approximately \$73 per class (TBD)

Step 2: Pay


- SchoolCashOnline – Webstore (not available for purchase at this time)
- \$100/ exam (\$55/exam for Free & Reduced)
- Pay for Fall semester and Exam Only courses by November 3, 2019
 - Fall Semester & Exam Only will have a \$40 late fee applied after the November 3, 2019 deadline.
- Pay for ½ credit spring semester classes in January (Government, Macroeconomics, Human & Psychology)

GPA Exemptions

 ➤ Recommended for juniors and seniors with a 4.0 GPA or higher (weighted) who participate in activity based classes.



➤ Must be 3rd or 4th year of a course with “B” average



➤ Course is excluded from GPA calculation

➤ Deadline is September 6, 2019 for fall semester

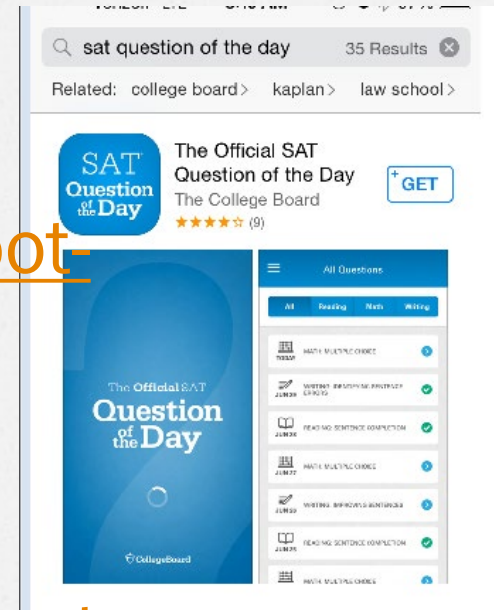

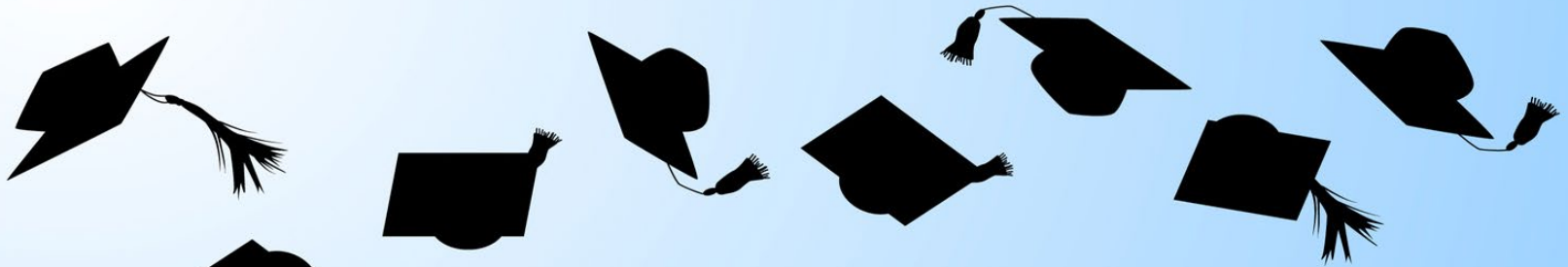
Upcoming Counselor Guidance Lessons in Wednesday Advisories
